WE MUST SEE THAT THE FOLLOWING POLICIES ARE BEING FOLLOWED:

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH

DOGS SHOULD BE TAKEN ELSEWHERE TO USE THE BATHROOM

“ACCIDENTS INVOLVING DOG WASTE MUST BE CLEANED IMMEDIATELY”

DOGS MUST STAY ON THE GROUND

“DOGS SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED ON CHAIRS, TABLES OR OTHER FURNISHINGS” AND “DOGS SHALL NOT COME INTO CONTACT WITH SERVING DISHES, UTENSILS AND TABLEWARE”

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING

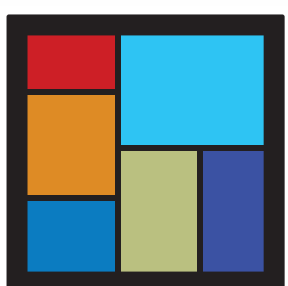
“THE AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT DEFINES A SERVICE ANIMAL AS A DOG THAT IS INDIVIDUALLY TRAINED TO DO WORK OR PERFORM TASKS FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY. DOGS WHOSE FUNCTION IS TO PROVIDE COMFORT OR EMOTIONAL SUPPORT DO NOT QUALIFY AS SERVICE ANIMALS ACCORDING TO THE ADA, EVEN WITH A DOCTOR’S NOTE.”

DOGS SHOULD BE FRIENDLY WITH PEOPLE & OTHER DOGS

“DANGEROUS AND POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS DOGS ARE PROHIBITED” AND

“A FOOD ESTABLISHMENT MAY EXCLUDE DOGS FROM THE PREMISES”
